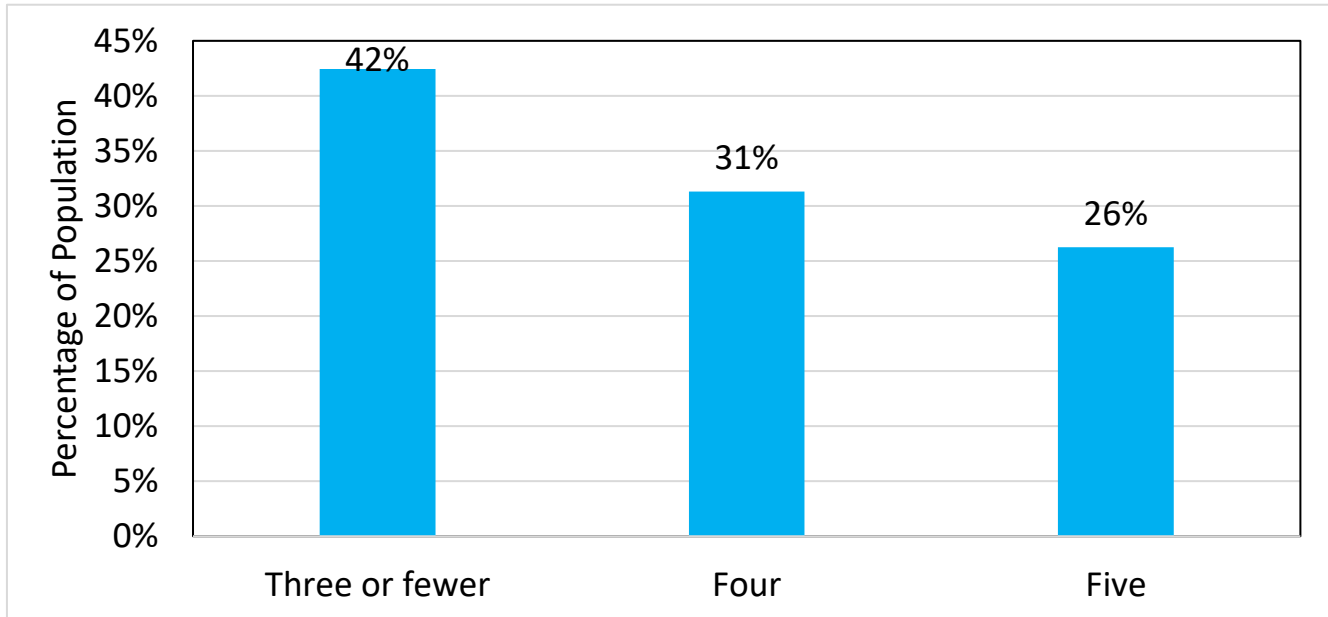
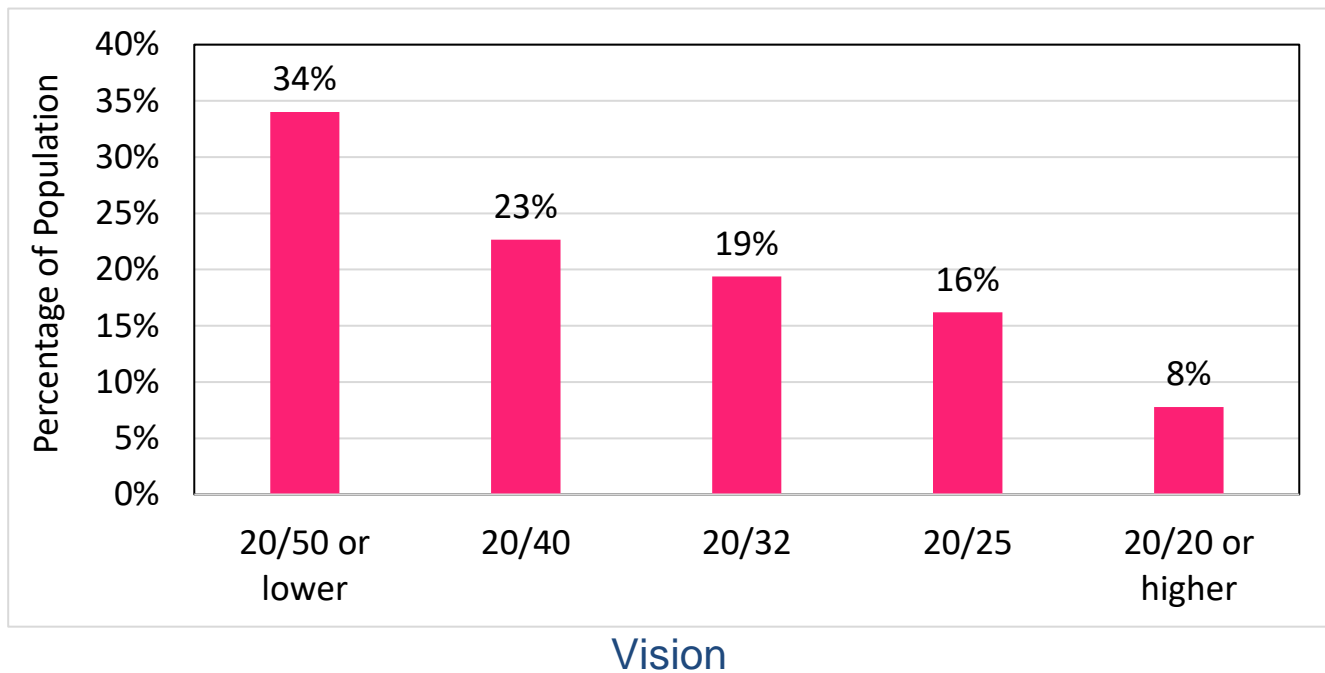

Olfaction (Smell)

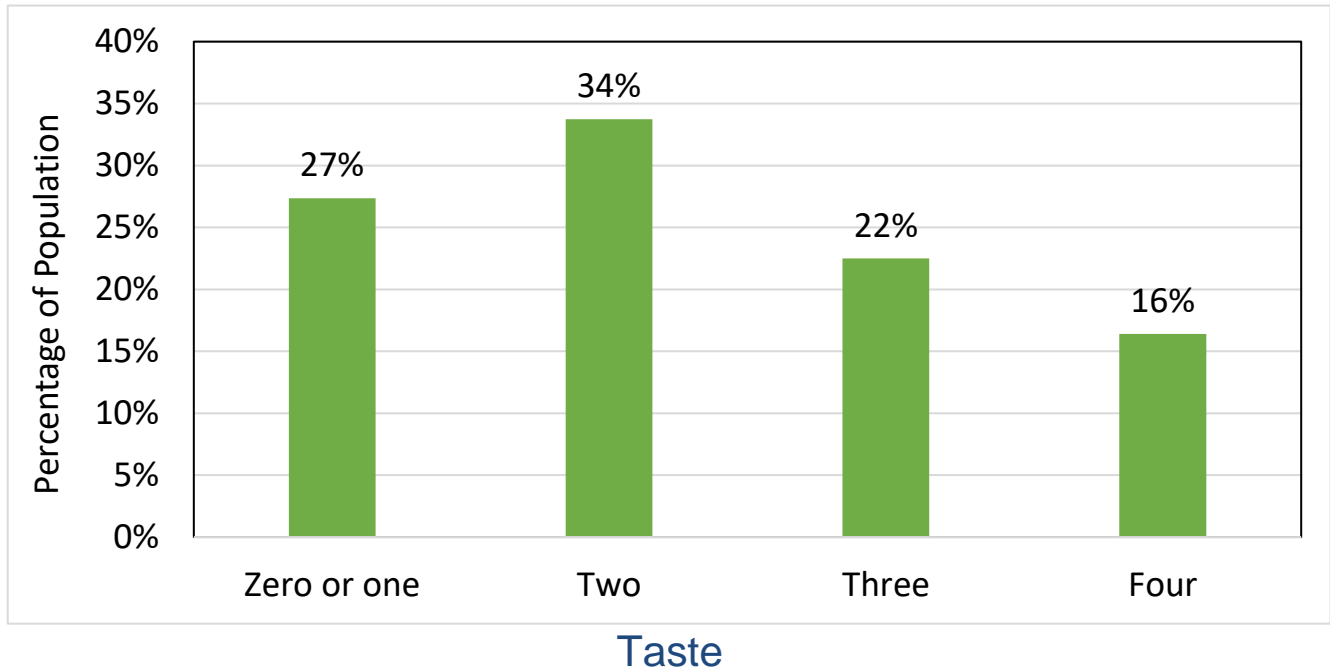


This chart shows the percentage (%) of men aged 75 and older in the U.S. who identified three or fewer, 4, or 5 odors correctly. Each bar is labeled with the number of odors correctly identified.

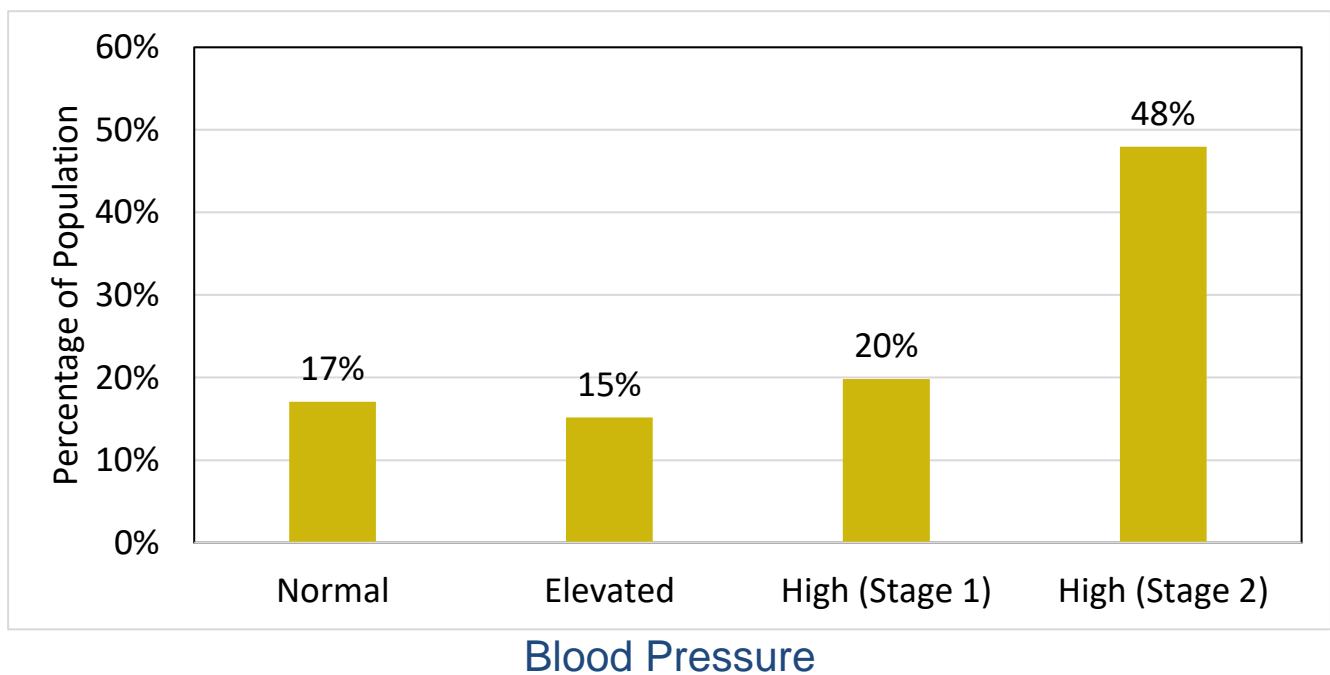


This chart shows the percentage (%) of men aged 75 and older in the U.S. with different visual acuity levels. Visual acuity is clarity or sharpness of vision. A 20/50 vision means you must be as close as 20 feet to see what a person with 20/20 vision can see at 50 feet. Each

bar is labeled with the visual acuity level.

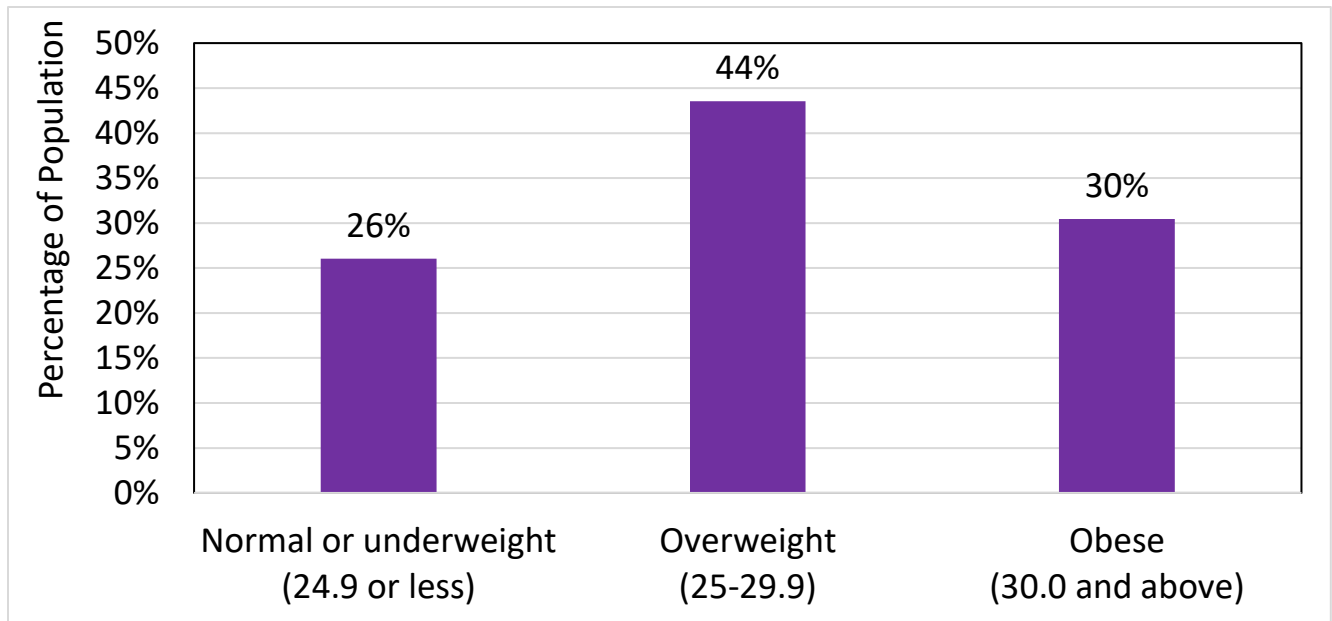
